- -long nails won't last long if you are working at the wheel so please be sensible

Tools-if you have pre-ordered a kit it will be available at your first class

-if you have your own tools here is the short list of what to bring: Cutting wire, pin tool, wooden tool, your favorite ribs (rubber, wooden, metal), a trimming tool, and of course any other personally preferred tools

Clay-is not included in the cost of adult classes

- -You will need to purchase clay at your first class
- -\$20 per bag cash or cheque only
- -Only clay purchased at the studio is to be used and fired at the studio
